NY Post gives Eliza Doolittle 4 stars

"To understand 22-year-old Londoner Eliza Doolittle, just spin her bright, melodic pop song "Moneybox," in which she chirps happily about the all-you-need-is-love simple life, singing, "Don't need a moneybox, cos I got lots and lots, of what I need right here, right here with you my dear." Her original songs are modern-retro in content and style, the latter of which hints at the clipped vocals of Petula Clark. Especially welcome is the bouncy cha-cha rhythm of "Go Home" and her contemporary doo-wop when she samples the Fleetwoods' huge 1959 hit "Come Softly to Me" into her own song "Missing." In an album of standouts, the top song is "Skinny Genes," where Doolittle lets a lover know exactly what she doesn't like about him. After the abuse in that one, she finally sings, "I don't mind it when you . . ." and then she whistles a few notes, letting your imagination fill in the blanks. Like much of this record, it's an old-fashioned double-entendre that's sexy and clever without approaching crass."

Roger Clyne & The Peacemakers offer up their Sombrero Solution

"Roger Clyne and the Peacemakers hosted the first-ever concert at Salt River Fields near Scottsdale Saturday, celebrating the release of their new album, *Unida Cantina*, and setting the Guinness World Record for most people wearing a sombrero in one location.

A full moon watched over the proceedings as concertgoers in shorts and sombreros made their way to the temporary stage set up along the third base line of the new spring training home of the Diamondbacks and Colorado Rockies.

Sounding like a rock and roll spaghetti western, the Tempe rockers started the festivities by ripping into their set with heavy guitar riffs, thumping drums and whining trumpets, fans counted in songs with "Uno, dos, tres, cuatro." With a splash of old fan favorites from Clyne's days with the Refreshments and songs off the new album, the Peacemakers kept fans happily singing along and thrusting their fists in the air.

The songs from *Unida Cantina* stuck with the Southwestern sound that Clyne has come to make his staple with tracks like "Marie," which was carried by a dreamy electric guitar hook as Clyne sang in English and Spanish. Other songs like "Go with the Flow" and "Paper Airplanes" were more reminiscent

of '90s alternative rock. Regardless of the tone of his songs, the underlying theme always comes back to moonshine, Mexico and having a good time.

And having a good time is something of a specialty when it comes to the RCPM faithful.

The crowd carried a cheerful vibe as they replenished their plastic beer cups and danced and sang their way throughout the venue. The sombreros only added to the good-natured feel of the night as two dudes walked around in oversized blowup hula girl outfits while others rocked straw hats of all shapes and sizes and donned ridiculous black mustaches.

Billed as the Sombrero Solution, Clyne engineered his celebration to also give something back to the community. Aside from setting a world record, proceeds from sombreros sold at the event and other participating locations went to Valley of the Sun United Way.

Guinness cameras recorded as a sea of decorated sombreros bobbed up and down and the crowd belted out, "They never work past noon around here, they sit side by side in the cantinas, talk to señoritas and drink warm beer."

One gate attendant said he clocked over 900 sombreros at his gate alone. He said they only needed 500 or so to break the record.
